Navigating the Course

The below icons indicate the type of activity, level of depth, and audience for each section. Use these icons to help you navigate through the course and select the sections and activities that best suit your interests.



Conceptual Overview

Each page starts with a video presentation providing a brief, narrated overview of the page topic. This content can also be accessed by reviewing the Presentation Audio Transcript linked in this section.



Text-Based Reflection

In this section, you will review a resource about the page topic and answer some reflection questions about the resource. For the purposes of this section, a text might be considered an article, blog post, graphic organizer, or a video.



Practice the Process

This section is designed to help you learn by doing. Use this section to practice developing proficiencies from scratch.



Adopt and Adapt

In contrast to the previous section, this section is designed to help you build off or refine existing proficiencies. Use this section to practice modifying existing proficiencies to fit a particular context. Please note, this section is only relevant to Questions 1 - 5 and therefore has not been included for Questions 6 - 10.

Evidence of Learning

Level of Depth
